

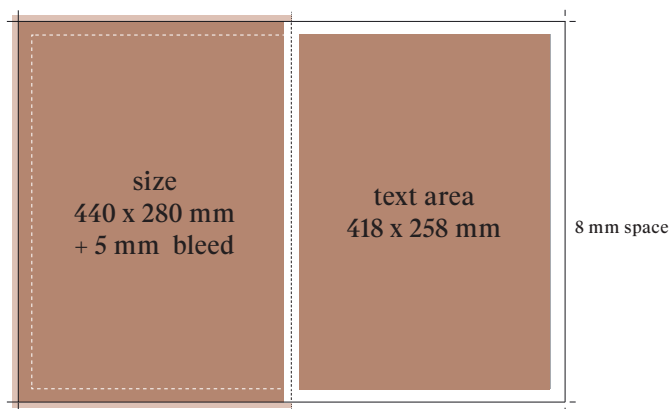

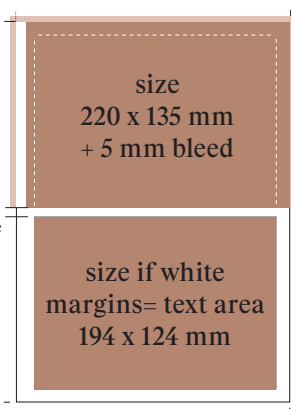

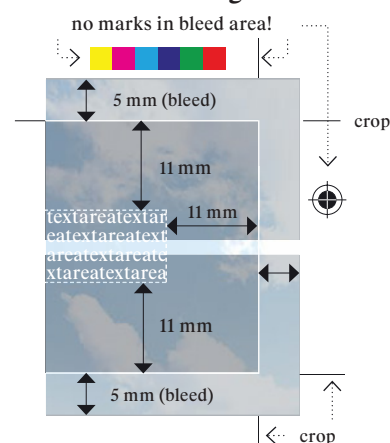
### 2/1 Double Page (Spread)



### 1/2 Page horizontal



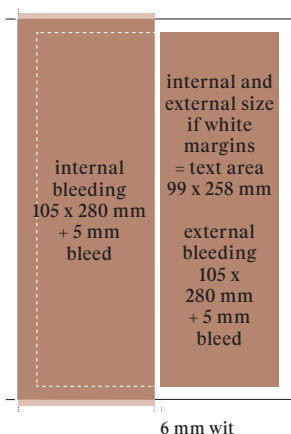
### External Margins



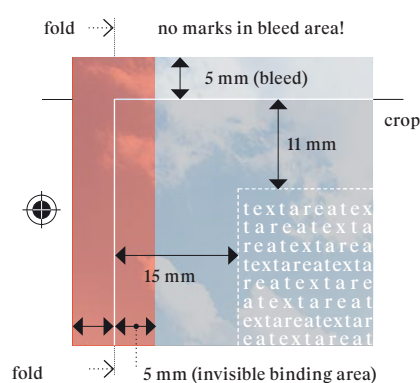
### 1/1 Single Page

## Size—Paper—Print

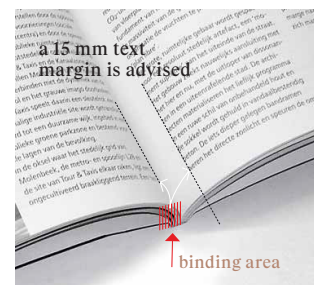
- size 220 x 280 mm
- paper 100 g/m<sup>2</sup>

The magazine is printed on FSC®-certified paper, with vegetable-based inks and low-alcohol (5%) diluents. All detergents are biodegradable. The cellophane wrapper used for sending is recyclable.

- PDF 300 dpi CMYK density max. 300%

- PLEASE NOTE invisible binding area 5mm from spine, consequently 10 mm in the centre of double pages
- for half page advertisements do not add separation lines, which will be added by A+
- the bleed area should not contain any crop marks, registration marks, colour bars or page information
- do respect (internal) margins equally for bound-in inserts
- **NO FLATTENING!**



- for good legibility of text and logos an internal text margin of 15 mm is advised
- in the binding area text and image are invisible
